I hope you all had a very happy and safe break. After having your wonderful and amazing children home for the last two weeks please make sure you let your child's teacher know how very much you do appreciate them.

Excursions

There are a number of excursions that I know have been planned for this term already. These are excellent opportunities for our students to expand their range of experiences and value add to their learning. Due to the location of Mount Pleasant we usually have to hire a bus to take the students on these excursions. Unfortunately our usual provider, Woodside Coaches, has sold their business. We have contacted 7 or 8 other companies and have found that their prices are significantly higher (50% to almost 200% higher in some cases). This means that the cost of any excursions from now on are going to be significantly higher. We try and keep the costs down by choosing excursions with no, or very low, entry costs and we do budget a set amount per student to help subsidise the costs of excursions but of course this will no longer go as far as we had planned at the beginning of the year. We will continue to investigate other companies and other options. In the meantime if you are finding it difficult to pay for your children to attend excursions please come and speak to me and I am sure we can work something out.

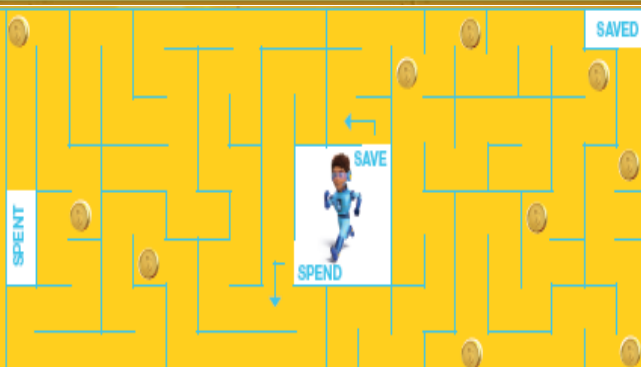
Good saving habits support your school.
